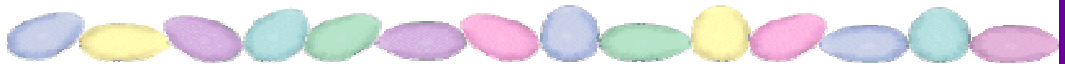

In an effort to better serve the residents of the Calhoun Housing Authority we are going to make the following changes: If a resident has a comment, concern or complaint please be advised that we now have a new procedure for contacting this office. Residents must fill out a form with their name, apartment number and their comment prior to meeting with a Housing Authority Representative.

All emergencies or criminal activity should be reported to the police or call 911 - then contact our office to advise us that you have made a call to the proper authorities.

L.E.J.O working for the residents

LEJO is here to help residents get job ready and find work. They are located at the 629 Harkins Street Imagination Station. They can help with basic computer training on Monday's and Tuesday's from 10:00 a.m.– 12:00 p.m. by appointment only. They offer assistance with RESUMEs, applications and interview preparation on Friday's by appointment only. LEJO offers Spanish classes on Friday mornings from 10:00 am - 12:00 p.m. LEJO can also give referrals for GED school and to 2Work Staffing Agency.

Free Legal Services Available

Georgia Legal Services is a non profit group of lawyers that provide access to justice and opportunities out of poverty for Georgians with low incomes.

The last Friday of every month from 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. Georgia Legal Services sends a lawyer to the LEJO offices in the old Imagination Station Building at 629 Harkins Street to make them available to the public in general, but more importantly to you the residents of the Calhoun Housing Authority. Examples of assistance: Domestic Violence, Medicaid/Food Stamp denial if family is clearly eligible, etc. Call for an appointment.

Did you Know.....

Income Changes or Annual Rent Recertification:

Section 9 of your lease states: Residents must report to the Landlord any of the following changes in household circumstances when they occur between Annual Rent Recertifications within 10 days of their occurrence:

- A member has been added to the family through birth, adoption, or court-awarded custody.
- A household member is leaving or has left the family unit.
- A new source of income.

Failure to report changes to your household within 10 days could result in you owing the Housing Authority back rent (Retro Rent).

It is the Calhoun Housing Authority's policy that if the amount of rent that you failed to pay due to failure to report any qualified changes is equal to or greater than \$500, it will be grounds for immediate termination and will be taken to court for prosecution.

According to the terms of your lease, your lease can be terminated for: **16 (b) failure to provide timely and accurate statements of income, assets, expenses and family composition at Admission, Interim, Special or Annual Rent Recertifications, to attend scheduled reexamination interviews or to cooperate in the verification process if the Resident has chosen to pay rent based on a percentage of income; (c) furnishing false or misleading information during the application or review process.**

Access to your apartment by the landlord:

Section 14 of your lease states: The Landlord shall provide **two (2) days written advance notice** to the Resident of his or her intent to enter the dwelling unit for the purpose of performing routine inspections and preventive maintenance, extermination or to show the dwelling unit for re-renting. The Resident shall permit the Landlord, his or her agents, or other persons, when accompanied by the Landlord, to enter the dwelling unit for these purposes. In the event that the Resident and all adult members of the household are absent from the dwelling unit at the time of entry, the Landlord shall leave a card stating the date, time and name of the person entering the dwelling unit and the purpose of the visit.

The Landlord may enter the dwelling unit **at any time without advance notice** when there is **reasonable cause to believe an emergency exists.**

The Calhoun Housing Authority gives advanced notice of exterminations and routine maintenance/inspection in the newsletter. It is always scheduled for the week that holds the first Monday and Tuesday each month during normal business hours.

Routine Maintenance is considered inspection of the apartment to determine what items may need to be repaired or replaced to prevent safety or health violations in an apartment or to prevent further damage to an existing condition that needs repair. If a need is identified, maintenance will advise when they will be back for repair.

Mowing and Yard Reminders



It is mowing time again. Please keep your yard free from toys, water hoses, and other obstacles that would get in the way of the mowers or that could be damaged by the mowers. We are not responsible for damage that may be caused by our mowers. A \$5.00 Mowing fee for **Family Units ONLY** will be charged on April 1, 2011.

You can wash your cars on the **pavement only**. Vehicles can not be pulled onto the grass.



As the weather is starting to warm up the kids will begin to play outside more. Please remember to store all toys inside of your apartment. Do not leave any riding toys outside or bicycles laying on the ground. BB Guns are not allowed on Housing Authority property.

Play Grounds and Lawn Care for the Calhoun Housing Authority



Play Grounds

We now have three new play grounds here in the authority. One is located across from the Imagination Station, one is located on short McConnell Road and the other is at Edwards Ave. We are very excited about being able to provide this equipment for the children. Please help us maintain the playgrounds and if anyone sees abuse or mistreatment on our grounds - please report your observations immediately to our main office or after hours on call phone. We have also planted trees and installed benches. Our hope is that the trees will provide shade as they become established.

Lawns

Over the past several years we have worked very hard to clean up our developments and give our properties a uniformed look with great curb appeal. We are starting to receive great compliments on our work but, we only have about one half of our properties completed. Please be patient with us as we continue to make the improvements. Please review the following Do's and Don'ts list to ensure that you are not violating your lease.

Do's

You may have flower pots sitting on your front and back porch. (limit 3 on the front and 3 on the back)
You may have outside lawn furniture - but keep it in good, safe condition
You may have one (1) Sheppard's hook
You may have vegetables Instead of flowers in your pots

Don'ts

Do not plant any type of flower, plant or shrubbery in the ground or along the sidewalks
No artificial plants are allowed in the trees or ground
No empty buckets, racks, hoses, brooms, mops or mop buckets, sticks, landscape timbers, of any kind
Decorative holiday lights or decals/stickers must come down 5 days after the holiday
No hand written signs on the front doors
No porch swings, ceramic figurines, wind mills, wind chimes etc

Keeping the yards and grounds mowed for 249 apartments is very time consuming during the summer. Please work with us and remember that maintenance is not responsible for damage to anything left unattended in your yard. Jelly Bean Chick

What you'll need:

- 1/3 cup jelly beans
- Pleated sandwich bag
- 1 large yellow pom pom
- 3 yellow foam hearts
- 2 small wiggle eyes
- Scrap of orange felt or foam
- Chenille stem
- Small pom pom (color to match chenille stem)
- White craft glue
- Scissors



How to make it:

1. Pour jelly beans into sandwich bag. Gather beans into one corner of the bag and twist chenille stem snugly around the bag.
 2. Trim the top of the bag, above the chenille stem, to about 1/2 inch. Fan out the top of the bag as if opening it to expose the center.
 3. Put a generous amount of white glue on the yellow pom pom and place on top of the bag.
 4. Put two yellow foam hearts next to each other on the table. These will be your chick's feet. Glue bag on top of the feet so that the rounded ends of the hearts are poking out the front.
 5. Cut the third yellow foam heart on half, these two pieces will be your chick's wings. Glue one to each side of the jelly bean bag.
 6. Glue wiggle eyes to the front of the pom pom head.
 7. Cut a small triangle from the orange felt or foam and glue on as the beak.
 8. Use the scissors to trim the ends of the chenille stem to about 2-3" each. Fold each side of the chenille stem in toward the center to look like a bow tie.
- Glue small pom pom to the center of the chenille bow tie.

Tips:

- If you don't have pleated sandwich bags you can use zipper bags, just cut the zipper top off before starting.
- You can make full yellow chicks by using all yellow jelly beans, however this may be cost prohibitive unless you buy your jelly beans from a store that sells individual colors in bulk.

As an alternative you can glue the wings inward toward the front of the jelly bean bag and glue a small slip of paper with the message "Happy Easter" on it in front. Keep in mind that this will hide the jelly beans on your project.
