

### **Jam Filled Heart Cookies**

#### **Ingredients:**

Your Favorite Sugar Cooke Recipe or I roll of purchased prepared Sugar Cookie Dough. 4 teaspoons seedless raspberry jam



#### **Cooking Instructions:**

Prepare the cookie dough according to your recipe, or open the roll of cookie dough.

On a piece of plastic wrap, roll half the dough into a 6x12-inch rectangle. Spread 2 teaspoons of jam over the entire rectangle. From the long side, roll up the dough to the middle of the rectangle. Roll up the other long side until it meets the other rolled side.

Heat oven to 350 degrees F. Cut roll crosswise into 3/8-inch-thick slices. Gently press sides and bottom (the opposite side from the rounded tops) to form a heart. Place hearts on cookie sheet about I inch apart. Chill in refrigerator 10 minutes. Repeat with second half of the dough and jam.

Bake about 14 minutes, or until the bottom is golden brown. Cool on cookie rack 10 minutes. Move cookies from baking sheet to cooling rack to cool completely.
