### *Important Notice For All Calhoun Housing Authority Residents*

*Dear Calhoun Housing Authority Residents,*

*The Calhoun Housing Authority Maintenance department will be conducting inspections the week of February 20, 2012 in the designated family units. It is not necessary for you to be in your unit when it is inspected. It is mandatory that every resident clean his or her apartment prior to the inspection. Your yard and the outside of your unit must be clean and swept. Outside windows must be swept out.*

*The best cleaning tip is to eliminate. Get rid of anything you no longer use. Once you have eliminated articles that you are not using it is much easier to organize and clean.*

*Walk through your apartment and make sure you are in compliance with your lease. Ensure that you are not blocking any windows or exits with furniture or other items. Do not have anything out that would be considered a tripping hazard.*

*For your lawns – please make sure that you are in compliance with our Lawn Care policy.*

## Jam Filled Heart Cookies

### Ingredients:

Your Favorite Sugar Cooke Recipe or 1 roll of purchased prepared Sugar Cookie Dough.  
4 teaspoons seedless raspberry jam

### Cooking Instructions:

Prepare the cookie dough according to your recipe, or open the roll of cookie dough.

On a piece of plastic wrap, roll half the dough into a 6x12-inch rectangle. Spread 2 teaspoons of jam over the entire rectangle. From the long side, roll up the dough to the middle of the rectangle. Roll up the other long side until it meets the other rolled side.

Heat oven to 350 degrees F. Cut roll crosswise into 3/8-inch-thick slices. Gently press sides and bottom (the opposite side from the rounded tops) to form a heart. Place hearts on cookie sheet about 1 inch apart.

Chill in refrigerator 10 minutes. Repeat with second half of the dough and jam.

Bake about 14 minutes, or until the bottom is golden brown. Cool on cookie rack 10 minutes. Move cookies from baking sheet to cooling rack to cool completely.
