New Procedure for Resident Complaints

If you have a complaint that cannot be resolved between you and your neighbor or have a general complaint or concern, the Calhoun Housing Authority now has a complaint form that can be picked up at the front desk any time between normal business hours.

The form must be completed and returned to the office. At that time you will be given a time for an appointment to discuss your complaint. This process will enable us to better serve our residents and to speed up resolutions of all complaints or concerns. When completing the form, please be sure to submit accurate and detailed information.

We will no longer take the complaints over the telephone. Your complaint must be in written form.

If you have any kind of an emergency, call 911. If you have to call 911 regarding a problem with a neighbor, please get the names of the responding officers for when you complete your complaint form.

LEJO is here to help residents get job ready and find work. They are located at the 629 Harkins Street Imagination Station. They can help with basic computer training on Monday's and Tuesday's from 10:00 a.m.– 12:00 p.m. by appointment only. They offer assistance with RESUMEs, applications and interview preparation on Friday's by appointment only. LEJO offers Spanish classes on Friday mornings from 10:00 am - 12:00 p.m. LEJO can also give referrals for GED school and to 2Work Staffing Agency.

Please call this office and tell us what your needs might be. You may need help with something that we have not provided. Let us know what you would like to see provided here in the Authority. Free Legal Services Available

Georgia Legal Services is a non profit group of lawyers that provide access to justice and opportunities out of poverty for Georgians with low incomes.

The last Friday of every month from 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. Georgia Legal Services sends a lawyer to the LEJO offices in the old Imagination Station Building at 629 Harkins Street to make them available to the public in general, but more importantly to you the residents of the Calhoun Housing Authority. Examples of assistance: Domestic Violence, Medicaid/Food Stamp denial if family is clearly eligible, etc. Call for an appointment.

Transportation in Gordon County

- **Gordon Transit** (706) 602-0852 will pick you up for \$1.50 and take you to any location in Gordon County. You need to contact them ahead of time to ensure that they can add you to their schedule route. For those of you who are working this is cheaper than driving and owning a car. Please take advantage of this service. Use them a time or two to see how well they work.
- **Legistacare** (Medicaid recipients) (800) 807-5030 offer travel service also.
- **South East Transit** (866) 388-9844- You must be a Medicaid recipient to ride this bus and you must call to receive an order to ride.

Diabetic information.....

If you have Diabetes, you may qualify for diabetic shoes. Please advise your physician if you feel you may have a need for special shoes.

Important Information regarding your lease.....

Please read the reminders below regarding rules for the Calhoun Housing Authority. If you are a new resident, please make yourself familiar with your lease. If you have trouble understanding something that is in your lease, please call the office so that we can assist you.

- **Swimming Pool** -Swimming pools must remain empty unless an adult is there to supervise the children. When not in use, pool must be empty and stored up against the back of the apartment. **DO NOT HANG ON THE CLOTHES LINES! NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- **Playground**- Children playing on the playgrounds **must** be accompanied by an adult. Please remember that your child must be supervised by an adult at all times. **YOU** are responsible for your child. Your neighbors are not responsible for your children. No children **over the age of 12** are allowed to play on the playground. Water guns are not allowed on the playground.
- **BB Guns**– BB Guns , sling shots, or other projectile toys are not allowed on Housing Authority property. You will be responsible for any damages caused by such toys and your lease could be terminated.
- **Parking**- Each apartment has a designated parking space. Do not use your neighbors parking space. If you have more than one approved vehicle, you must use a visitor's space to park. Please have all visitors park in a visitor's parking spot. Visitor's parking is first come first served. Visitor's parked in designated visitor's parking spaces do not have to move at the request of a resident. In some developments, parking is very limited. Residents are not allowed to park in visitor's parking spaces in order to prohibit others from using the space. Please be considerate of your neighbors and park properly. **DO NOT** park on the sidewalk. Residents and visitors that use wheelchairs cannot travel down the sidewalk if you are blocking it. Each resident is responsible to have your guests to park in the parking spot that is designated for your apartment or in a designated visitor's spot. There is only one parking place per apartment. Please be considerate of your neighbors. Every car has to have a parking decal on the windshield that is issued from the Calhoun Housing Authority office.

Chocolate-Dipped Frozen Bananas



Ingredients:

- 8 medium bananas, peeled
- 8 wooden Popsicle sticks
- 32 ounces semisweet chocolate, chopped or chips
- 4 tablespoons unsalted butter

Directions:

1. Dipping decorations: granola, chopped nuts, sprinkles, jimmies, crushed cookies, and toasted coconut
2. Line a sheet pan with waxed paper. Cut 1-inch off the end of each banana. Insert a Popsicle stick into the cut-end of each banana, pushing the stick halfway in, leaving the other end exposed for use as a handle. Place the bananas on the sheet pan and freeze 1 hour.
3. Melt the chocolate and butter in a bowl over a saucepan of simmering water, stirring occasionally.
4. Arrange the dipping decorations on several flat plates. Working with 1 banana at a time, dip it in the chocolate and turn to completely coat (spoon some on, if needed). Roll the dipped banana in the desired decorations, transfer to the sheet pan, and return to the freezer.
5. Once frozen, store the bananas in an airtight container.

Serving suggestion: To serve at a kid's party, paint a hunk of Styrofoam and stick the banana handles in the top, so they stand upright.
